The Village of Oakwood hereby enters into agreement with the Sheriff's Department of Clay County, Missouri, to enforce the ordinances of the Village of Oakwood. This will include but not necessarily be limited to:

- 1. Enforcing posted speed limits to the extent of reminding violators of the limits required by ordinance.
- 2. Enforcing the prohibition of the discharge of firearms and ammunition by issuing a warning for a first violation and a citation with a fine of \$100.00 for a second violation.
- 3. Enforcing the required restraint and vaccination of dogs by issuing a warning for a first violation and a citation with a fine of \$100.00 for a second violation. If the violation continues, each day's violation will be regarded as a separate offense.
- 4. Enforcing the prohibition of the use of fireworks by issuing a warning for a first violation and a citation with a fine of \$250.00 for a second violation. If the violation continues, a citation with a fine of \$500.00 will be issued.

It is understood that the Sheriff's Department provides insurance coverage for any Deputy sent to respond to a complaint.

It is understood that the cost of this service is \$13.00 per hour plus \$0.17 per mile car expense and that the Village will be charged for a minimum of four (4) hours per any one request for ordinance enforcement.

This agreement does not preclude or substitute for regular patrol of the Village of Oakwood by the Sheriff's Department.

This agreement may be rescinded by either party with thirty (30) days written notice.
