NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD, CLAY COUNTY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: That the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood hereby vacates and abandons property known now as a Village right of way on the recorded plat of Oakwood First Addition, Plat Book 5, pp. 66 and 67. This property is within the boundaries of Lot 3, Oakwood First Addition, Block 7, address of 945 South Woodland Drive. The property is bordered on the north by South Woodland Drive and is bordered on the east by North Clements Avenue. Survey description and drawing of vacated right of way are provided in "Exhibit A" attachment to this Ordinance.
- Section 2: That at no place shall the standard 50 foot Village of Oakwood right of way be reduced to less than 50 feet wide, regardless of the shown position of the road upon that right of way whether in previous or recent surveys. Therefore, the vacation of right of way line shall be no closer to its opposing right of way line than 50 feet
- Section 3: That in addition, at no place shall the vacation of right of way line be closer than 25 feet from the existing street centerline, even when the result is maintaining a greater than 50 foot wide total road right of way.
- Section 4: That any and all expenses for vacating the right of way area shall be borne by the requesting beneficiary.
- Section 5: That the Village of Oakwood shall retain right of way privledges with regard to South Woodland Drive and North Clements Avenue.
- Section 6: That the vacated and abandoned right of way shall revert to the adjoining property holder of record as of this day.

An area of land in the subdivision of Oakwood First Addition in the southwest quarter of Section 26. Township 51 North, Range 33 West, in Clay County, Missouri described as follows:

Oakwood First Addition: thence easterly on a curve to the left, with an initial tangent bearing of South 83° 14' 34" East, a radius of 1049.76 feet, a central angle of 16° 13' 24", and an arc distance of 297.24 feet; thence South 01° 06' 55" West, 195.46 feet; thence Northwesterly, along the Northeasterly property line of said Lot 3, on a curve to the left, with an initial tangent bearing of North 01° 06' 55" East, a radius of 170.00 feet, a central angle of 84° 35' 32", and an arc distance of 250.95 feet to a point of tangency; thence North 83° 27' 54" West, 142.63 feet to the Point of Beginning.
